WESTERN CATHOLICS:

*Guardian angels* (Roman and Ambrosian calendars)

COPTS AND ETHIOPIANS (22 tut/maskaram):

*Cotylas, Axoua and Tatas of Persia* (4th cent.), martyrs (Coptic Church)

LUTHERANS:

*Peter Carnesecchi* (d. 1567), witness to the point of bloodshed in Italy

MARONITES:

*Cyprian and Justina of Antioch* (d. 304), martyrs

ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS AND GREEK CATHOLICS:

*Cyprian of Antioch*, ieromartire

*Justina of Antioch*, virgin and martyr

*Theodore of Smolensk* (d. 1299) and *his sons David and Constantine*, thaumaturges (Russian Church)

OLD CATHOLICS:

*Leodegarius of Autun* (d. ca. 680), bishop and martyr
